Opening:

What Are We Seeing Today?

The Palestinian flag is being raised around the world with people screaming to free Palestine (from the river to the sea). This means that they are calling for the removal of Israel completely. And that Israel can no longer exist, claiming that its inception in 1948 was an illegal occupation of the Palestinians state.

Let's examine their claim.

Whose land, is it? Where did the Palestinian State come from?

History:

David & King Solomon – kings of Israel – there were many kings of Israel over the years.

Israel in its current land existed way before Islam.

Two important concepts you need to know that they are using to rebuttal history:

Islam's Case:

Palestine Case:

Palestine: has there ever been a state called Palestine? No. There has never been a Palestinian King, President, or government. Where did this come from?

The current state of Israel was reestablished in 1948.

The Jewish people declared independence.

Next day 6 Arab nations attacked Israel: Syria, Lebanon, Iraq, Egypt, Jordan, Yemen, & Saudi. No Palestinian army or entity fought in this war simply because there was never such a thing as Palestine.

In 9 months all six Arab nations were defeated. Israel was not supported by the US prior to its independence and bought used weapons from WWII from Europe.

Even Great Britain backed the Arab side. But Israel won through patriotism, courage, self-sacrifice, and their desire for a right to exist.

Prior to Israel independence war of 1948 the land belonged to the greater kingdom of Jordan (Transjordan).

Prior to the six-day war of 1967, Gaza Strip was an Egyptian land.

The west bank was a Jordanian land. Jerusalem was also part of the kingdom of Jordan.



The Creation of the Palestinian entity

In March 1964 Gamal Abdel Nasser was then the president of Egypt and a very ambitious leader who wanted to build a Pan-Arab dynasty and empire.

Nasser built a coalition with Syria. His goal was always to remove Israel off the map and be the ruler of the Arab nation and to take over the whole Middle East.

The Syrians revolted and separated from Egypt in 1961.

All Arab nations had the goal of removing Israel from the land. They knew that whoever did it would be a hero to the Arab world.

1963 – Syria wanted to go into a war against Israel and secure that dream of annihilation of the state of Israel. Nasser got in the way and told them No.

Cairo Declaration

1964 – 14 Arab nations met in Egypt – the Cairo Declaration – Egyptian President, Nasser was the leader of the group – they agreed to create a Palestinian entity, the State of Palestine. The (Palestinian Liberation organization) PLO was formed. The infamous Yasser Arafat was later appointed the leader and for many years.

They then looked for a flag and decided on an old generic flag that has been used by Saudi Arabia, Iraq, and Yemen.

This is how the state of Palestine was formed.

Conclusion

From our Bible and our theology, we understand that Jesus walked the streets of Jerusalem. We know about the prophets and the history of this area.

We know about Moses, David, the kings, and the prophets that are well documented. We compare this to the two theories of the Palestinians Palestinian history and claims and there is no comparison.
