## Jesus, Head of the Church

### As mental structures

- Christianity influences the way we perceive the world around us and the values we accept or reject.
- Attitudes towards vice and virtue in diverse fields.
- The teachings of Jesus, such as the Parable of the Good Samaritan, is the most important source of modern notions of "human rights" and the welfare commonly provided by governments in the West.

## Global Faith

### Social Structures:

- Christianity provides a supporting network and a sense of belonging.
- Welfare, founding hospitals, economics, work ethic, natural law (which would later influence the creation of international law), politics, architecture, literature, personal hygiene, and family life.
- Babies, marriage, divorce, weddings, prolife and sexuality.

### Politics and government:

Christianity in the USA, since its inception, has become the basis of power structures and has become intertwined with it.

### Statistics on religions worldwide:

- 1.3 Billion consider themselves secular, non-religious, or agnostic.
- 2.4 Billion are Christians. ( 1.4 billion catholic and 1.0 billion protestant).
- 1.7 billion are Muslims. ( 90% of the world's Muslims are Sunni and 10% are Shia).
- Only, 14 million are jews (Judaism).

## Statistics on religions worldwide:

*Dharmic religions or Indic religions  
and Chinese religions (Emphasis on social structures)*

- Hinduism 900 million.
- Chinese religions 394 million.
- Buddhism 376 million.
- Sikhism 23 million.
- Zoroastrianism(Iran and Persia) 2.6 million.

## Proselytization (Evangelization)

***It simply means to convert or attempt to convert (someone) from one religion, belief, or opinion to another.***

### Global Faith

- Illegal in most of Muslim countries (If Legal it is on paper only to avoid human rights violations and punishments)
- Some countries such as Morocco prohibit it except for Islam.
- Some restrict it in various other different ways.
- The three main religions classified as missionary religions are Buddhism, Christianity, and Islam, while the non-missionary religions include Judaism, Zoroastrianism, and Hinduism.

### Global Faith

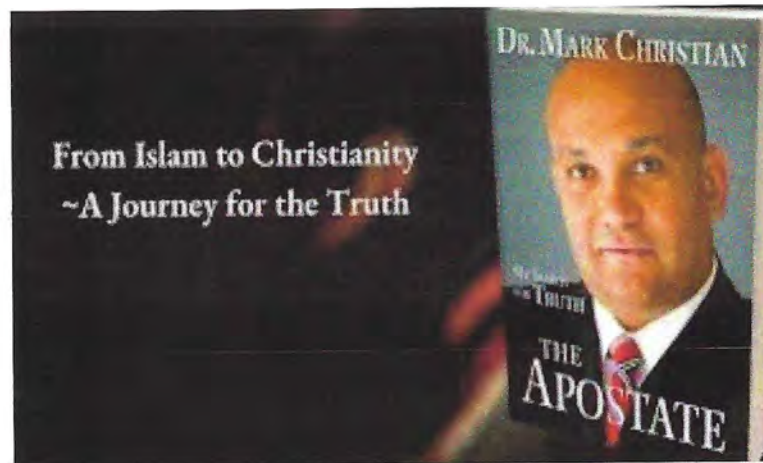
- 77% of new converts to Islam are from Christianity.
- Approximately 12.5 million more people converted to Islam than people converted to Christianity in the last 10 years.
- 30,000 converting to Islam annually in the United States.
- 5,000 British people convert to Islam every year, with most of them being women
- Limitations and regulations on proselytism are considered as infringements on freedom of religion and freedom of speech

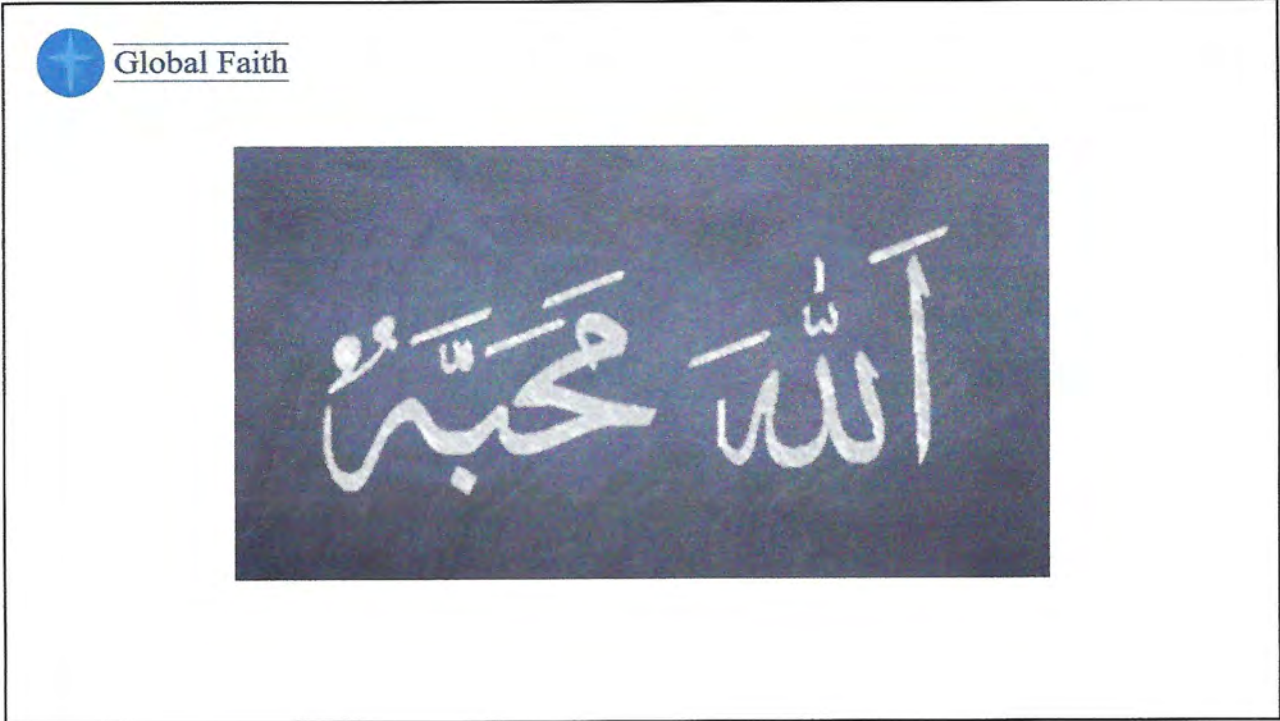

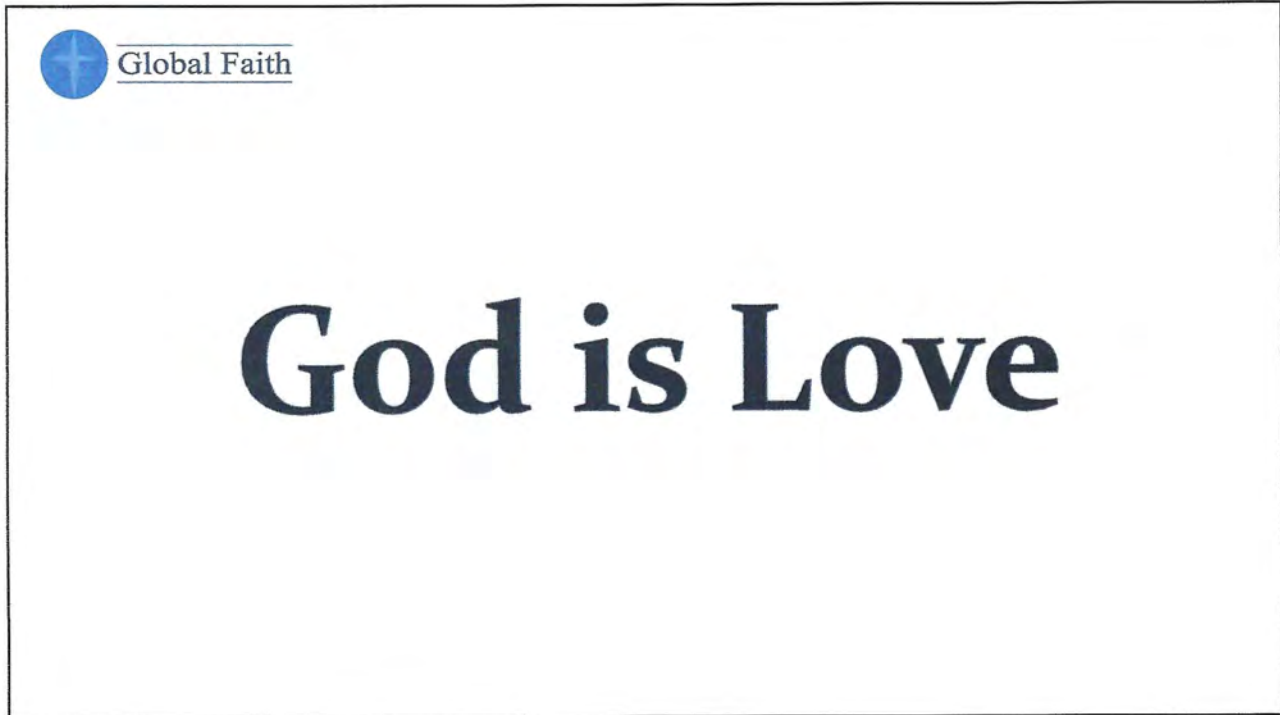

## Apostasy in Islam

- Allah's Apostle said, "The blood of a Muslim who confesses that none has the right to be worshipped but Allah and that I am His Apostle, cannot be shed except in three cases: In Qisas for murder, a married person who commits illegal sexual intercourse and the one who reverts from Islam (apostate) and leaves the Muslims." — *Sahih al-Bukhari, 9:83:17*
- Allah's Apostle said: "The blood of a Muslim man who testifies that there is no god but Allah and that Muhammad is Allah's Apostle should not lawfully be shed except only for one of three reasons: a man who committed fornication after marriage, in which case he should be stoned; one who goes forth to fight Allah and His Apostle, in which case he should be killed or crucified or exiled from the land; or one who commits murder for which he is killed." — *Sunan Abu Dawood, 38:4339*

## Other ways they punish apostacy

- The penal code, while not addressing blasphemy by name, states that "disdaining and disrespecting" any of the "heavenly religions" is punishable by six months' to five years' imprisonment
- Using religion with the aim of inciting strife or contempt of the "heavenly religions" or their sects or harming national unity carries penalties ranging from six months' to five years' imprisonment.
- "violating the family principles of Egyptian Society" with a minimum imprisonment of six months
